Completing the items on this checklist as soon as possible will make it substantially easier for your parents or others who will be assisting you to communicate with our office and to conduct business with us on your behalf. For example, after July 1, all entering students are protected by federal privacy laws that prevent us from disclosing information about your account to anyone other than the student. The checklist contains information on how you can grant permission to specific individuals you want to have contact us freely.

Student Financial Services will be presenting at Orientation, so be sure to attend when you come to Grounds. We will also be at the Orientation Resource Fair, where you can get specific questions asked and answered.
