Summer Update

Summer Comprehensive Fee Change

Since Summer classes are online due to COVID-19 the Summer comprehensive fee amount was reduced as stated below. The rates were changed in SAFM on May 4, 2020 so you will need to recalculate students awarded prior to that date.

SAFM 2020-21: Update

Health Insurance

The health insurance rate has been approved for \$2,980.

The rate has been updated so the Award Status box is now open and you can move the grad health subsidy awards through the workflow - and it will interface from SAFM to the Departmental Aid area of SIS.

Fall Semester

At this time the University has appointed a committee to evaluate options for students to return to campus for the fall semester based on COVID-19 modeling data presently available. The three options that are currently being reviewed are:

- 1. The fall semester dates remain the same, but two seven-week "modules" would be embedded in the semester. Some courses would be taught for the full semester and some courses would be delivered in the seven-week intensive format.
- 2. Delay the start of the fall semester by approximately one month in order to plan for the delivery of as many in-person courses as possible.
- 3. The fall semester dates remain the same with most or all instruction delivered online to start. Courses would transition to in-person instruction as soon as possible as conditions allow.

The decision is supposed to be made by mid-June.

The FST project has been delayed at least 6 months.

The goal of the FDM transition in SIS will be to keep existing functionality but to redefine the fields according to the new FDM and to take opportunities to leverage any new WorkDay functionality that could improve processes.

SAFM Access

Reminder: When new users submit an ESHARP request for the UV FA SAFM User role, they do not need to request separately access to UBI reporting (for the SAFM reports). They also do not need to request separate access for the UV SF Viewer Departments role (which allows users to view the Student Finance Customer Accounts and Item Line Detail). All of this is included with the UV FA SAFM User role.
