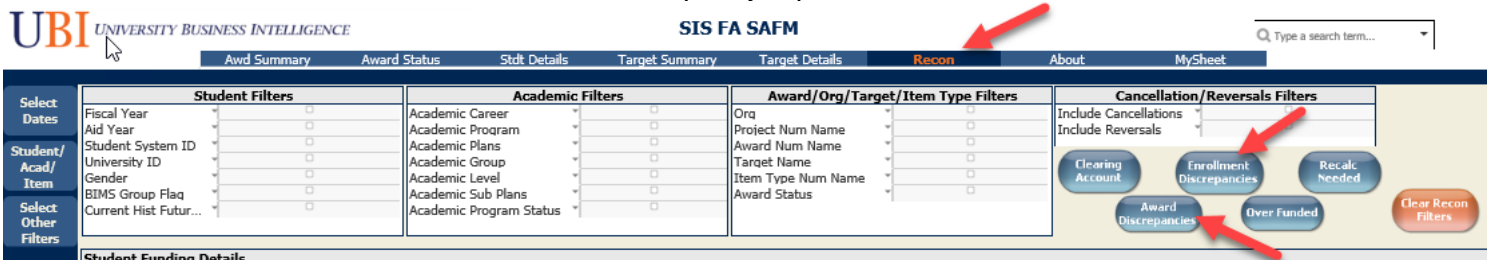

Reminder: Tasks in SAFM (PIAEO)

- This occasionally comes up from time to time, so we just wanted to remind everybody: for all tasks in SIS, they must be 8 or fewer characters.

Reminder: Enrollment Discrepancy Reports (UBI)

- These are reports used to reconcile data in SAFM with enrollment data, residency, and citizenship status.
- UBI:
 - Navigate to UBI, then pull up SIS_FA_SAFM.
 - Click on the Recon tab at the top.
 - Two helpful SAFM reconciliation reports on that tab are entitled the Enrollment Discrepancy report (button) and the Award Discrepancy (button) report. (See the blue buttons below.)
 - For fixed rate schools, the Enrollment discrepancy report would not apply. You should run the Award Discrepancy report instead.

Reminder: Health Insurance

Charges Posted

- UVA posted the Aetna Student Health Insurance plan annual premium of \$2,814 to the SIS accounts of students who enrolled, failed to submit adequate documentation, or whose health plans were determined not to provide comparable coverage.

Canceling Health Insurance for Students that Waived

- Scenario: Department entered health insurance for student, moved it to Approved, and the award is now Processed. However, the student waived their health insurance. The department needs to reverse the entry and move it through the workflow.
- To find these students: UBI SAFM Award Status Report, look for health insurance in Error, Error Reason, "Subsidy award was declined when award status is in processed."
- Find the student's award on the SAFM Awarding page; reverse the award and move it through the workflow.

SIS FA SAFM Health Subsidy Action Report

- In UBI, there is a "SIS FA SAFM Health Subsidy Action" report. This report identifies students who have enrolled in the student health plan and have a health subsidy award in SAFM, but the award is not in the processed status. Please run this report and make sure to move your students' awards through the workflow.

Health Insurance Life Events, Pro-rated Amounts

- If a student has a qualifying life event, they may be able to sign up for health insurance mid-year (after the enrollment period has ended.)
 - The student should email hardwaiver@virginia.edu to request enrollment into the Aetna Student Health plan within 30 days of losing current insurance coverage. Student Health will calculate the premium and complete the enrollment application.
 - A prorated amount will be calculated and added to the student's SIS account.
- You can award a subsidy for the QLEs. The health insurance award/item type defaults to the amount charged on the account.
- You can find the actual charge on the student's account via the View Customer Accounts page in SIS.

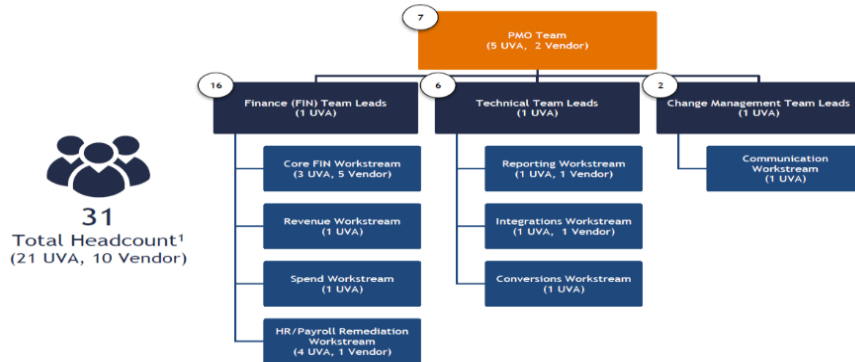
Financial Strategic Transformation

Prevent Issues Associated with Adding Additional Fund Source Rows

For the first time, we were seeing issues with users attempting to add fund source rows at unusual times. We modified SAFM to prevent users from being able to do this in SAFM.

SAFM 2019/20 Enhancements - Int'l Student Box Unchecked to Checked, Display Pop-up, Allow Recalc

Note: On the discrepancy report, we identified students who were needed to be recalced.

However, when you went into the Student Awarding page to recalc them, you had to click save before you would get the message instructing the user to recalc; upon save, the recalc button

was available. We want to change this as the user may not know that they have to click save in order to recalc. When the user comes into the page, a pop-up should display and they should be able to recalc at that time.

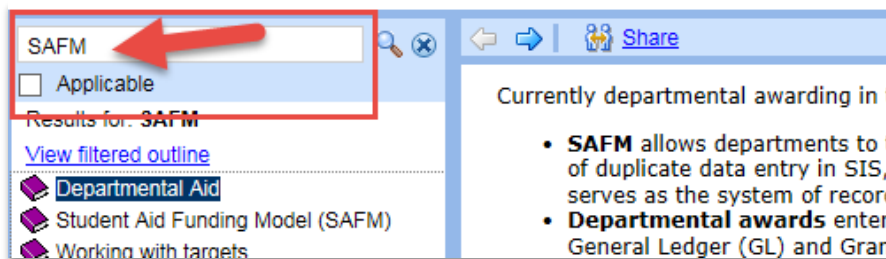
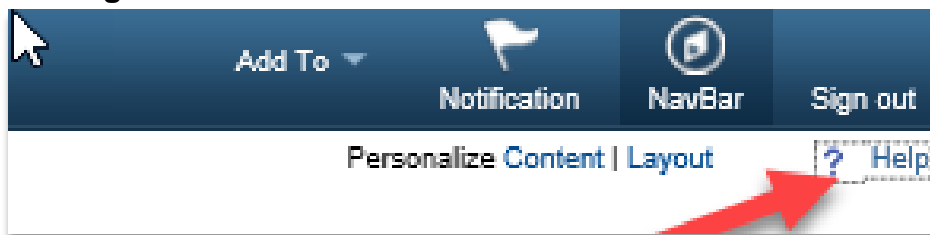
If international student checkbox is not checked, and the student has been charged the fee, the system checks the international student box and sets the recalc flag. At that time, display pop-up message if the user needs to recalc; allow user to recalc.

Default New ARG Academic Categories that Include Design Tech. Fee

Students in Architecture can be defaulted/awarded with the “MA/MS” academic category. However, the amount set up for the MA/MS academic category does not include the design tech. fee permutations. So, the amount in SAFM will not match what the student is truly charged. We will add additional academic categories to the setup and then modify SAFM so that the appropriate academic category based on what the student is being charged will be defaulted in SAFM.

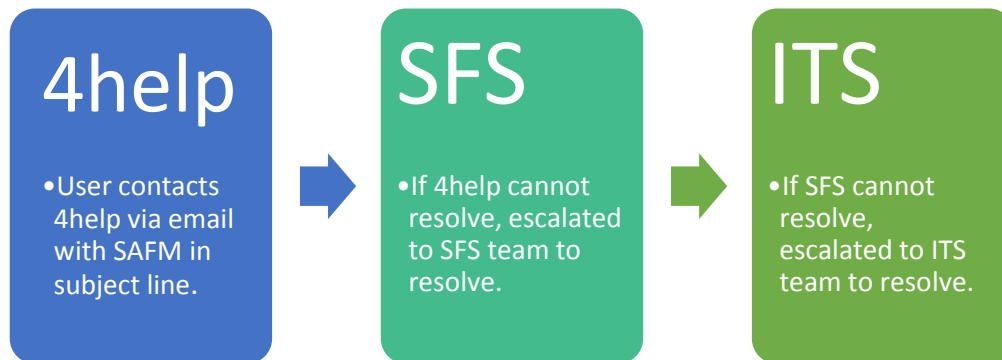
