

SAFM Recalculations Quick Guide – Workflow Changes

SAFM Recalculations:

Recalculation of tuition and fees may be required when there are changes to the student's enrollment or other student status changes (residency, international, etc.). These recalculations will automatically change the affected awards status to REJECTED. The award and/or fund sources must be modified and sent back through the workflow as necessary in order to accommodate the recalculations.

- A. If enrollment or student status has changed affecting tuition charges, the system will display an alert indicating that recalculation is required any time the SAFM student awarding page is accessed.
- B. Selecting the Recalculate Package button will recalculation and update the appropriate waiver item types.
 - i. If there is a discrepancy between an award amount and fund source amount totals for any item type due to the recalculation, the system will automatically change the award status for those item types to REJECTED.
 - ii. Note that fund sources that are in 'Processed' status will remain in 'Processed' status even though the award status has been changed to 'Rejected'. If a fund source is in any status other than 'Processed' the system will also change the fund source status to 'Rejected'.
- C. The Reject Reason code will be 'Fund source amt <> award amt' for all associated fund sources regardless of fund source status.
- D. The rejected awards will need to be modified and moved back to READY status so the corrected and/or new fund sources can be processed. See the SAFM Rejections Quick Guide.
