## Household Size Form 2021-2022

### Purpose of Form

Generally, the Household Size Form is requested when there is lack of agreement between the responses on a student's Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the CSS PROFILE regarding either the number of people in the custodial parent's household or the number children enrolled in college or both. This form may also be requested in order to confirm the identity of the family members reported in the custodial parent's household size and/or number in college. Independent students should only list themselves, along with their spouse and dependents (if applicable).

### General Instructions

If you are a *dependent* student, complete this form to confirm the number of family members in *your parent(s)'s* household. If you are an *independent* student, complete this form to confirm the number of family members in *your* household. Include the college enrollment plans for those family members who will be attending during 2021-2022. **Do not abbreviate the names of any colleges or universities you include in the table;** instead, write the full name of every institution.

### Family members for *dependent* students include:

- Yourself (the student)
- Your parent(s)
  - If your parents are married and only geographically separated, include both parents in the household
  - If your parents are divorced or separated but live together, include both parents in the household
  - If your parents are divorced or separated and do not live together, only include your custodial parent
  - If your custodial parent is remarried, include both your custodial parent and your stepparent
- Your parent(s)' other dependent children, including unborn children, who will receive more than 50% of their support from your parent(s) from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022
- Other people (including the domestic partner of your custodial parent), if they now live with your parent(s), and if your parent(s) provide more than 50% of their support, and if they will continue to provide more than 50% of their support from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022

### Family members for *independent* students include:

- Yourself (the student)
- Your spouse (if you are married)
- Your children, including unborn children, if you will provide more than 50% of their support from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022
- Other people (including your domestic partner) if they now live with you, and you provide more than 50% of their support, and if you will continue to provide more than 50% of their support from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022

In most cases, changes to the household size and number in college are prohibited by federal regulation once a student's application is verified. Please note that we may require additional documentation if we believe that the information regarding the household member(s)' enrollment in eligible postsecondary educational institutions is unclear or inaccurate.

Forms received without the appropriate signature(s) or with missing information or missing pages are considered incomplete and must be resubmitted. This will delay the evaluation of your financial aid eligibility and the awarding of your financial aid.
