## Student Estimated Income Form 2022-2023

### Purpose of Form

The Student Estimated Income Form is used to document the student's (and, if married, the student's spouse's) income in the 2022 calendar year, and may be submitted with certain Appeals for Reconsideration. **Along with this signed form, please remember to submit the two most recent year-to-date paystubs for you and, if you're married, your spouse for all employers. Additional documentation may be requested after we review this document.**

### General Instructions

Please do not submit this form unless or until you have been unemployed for at least 90 days.

### **Table A: Taxable Income**

On this table, report all sources of student/spouse estimated taxable income for 2022.

In Column A, report the total amount of income already received from January 1, 2022, through the day that you sign and complete this form, from each of the sources listed (wages, rental income, taxable interest, etc.). This is considered actual income. In Column B, report the total amount of income that you expect to receive from the day that you sign and complete this form through December 31, 2022, from each source. This is considered estimated income.

Be sure to report all sources of income, including those from foreign sources.

In the last row of Table A, enter the sum of all values reported in Column A, and the sum of all values reported in Column B.

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**Table B: Untaxed Income and Benefits**

On this table, report all sources of student/spouse estimated untaxed income for 2022.

In Column A, report the total amount of untaxed income already received from January 1, 2022 through the day that you sign and complete this form, from each of the sources listed (child support, tax-exempt interest, housing allowance, etc.). This is considered actual income. In Column B, report the total amount of untaxed income that you expect to receive from the day that you sign and complete this form through December 31, 2022, from each source. This is considered estimated income.

Be sure to report all sources of income, including those from foreign sources.
